

MATH 109, Report Awards and Reflection Highlights

Objectives:

- To look back at your weekly reports from the semester and celebrate what you learned.
- To look back at your weekly reflections from the semester and identify significant moments that you want to remember.

Instructions:

1. Choose 2-3 of your previously submitted weekly reports to receive “awards.”
 - Possible awards: "Most Challenging," "Most Insightful," "Most Interesting," "Most Relevant," "Most Fun," "Best Collaboration," "Most Persistence," "Most Effort," "Mastery," etc..
2. For each report that you choose for an award, state the award given and write a paragraph (at least three sentences) discussing the reasons why.
3. Choose 2-3 of your previously submitted weekly reflections to highlight.
 - Choose the reflections that described your more significant moments from the class this semester.
4. Include copies of each of your highlighted reflections.
5. Write a paragraph or two about why you chose to highlight these moments. Do you see any of these moments having any impact on you in the future? If so describe what the impact may be.
